Dear Colleagues,

We are pleased to send you the second announcement for the 13th Heavy Ion Accelerator Technology Conference (HIAT2015), which will be held in Yokohama, Japan from September 7 to 11, 2015. The conference will be hosted by RIKEN Nishina Center.

HIAT is an international conference dedicated to the design, construction, development and operation of heavy-ion accelerators and their components. It focuses on the operational experience of existing facilities, achievements in heavy-ion accelerator physics and technology, progress on the implementation of new projects and infrastructure upgrades, and trends in the proposal and design of heavy ion accelerators as well as their main systems and components.

The deadline for manuscript submission is September 5, 2015.

Proceedings

The conference proceedings will be published through the Joint Accelerator Conference Website (JACoW). The conference proceedings will be archived by JACoW and available worldwide through the JACoW servers.

Student Financial Support

Financial support will be available to a selected number of students. It will cover a part of living expenses for a period of this conference. The student category applies to students registered for a Ph.D. or Master's degree or Bachelor's degree in accelerator physics or engineering. Supported students will be expected to assist the speakers and delegates during the conference sessions and registration formalities.

In order to be considered for support, students must register poster session and posters should be mounted during reception on Sunday, September 6, in addition to regular session on Monday/Wednesday. They must arrive at the conference venue prior to opening of the registration desk, so that they can attend a compulsory orientation and training session on Sunday afternoon.

How to Participate and Apply for Student Financial Support

To be considered for financial support, you must:

- Register as student, upload your certificate and mention in the comment section that you are applying for financial support. Registration will open on **April 15, 2015**.
- Send an email to hiat2015@ribf.riken.jp and provide your Curriculum Vitae and a recommendation letter from your supervisor or group leader.

Please note that all applications and recommendations must be sent by **May 27, 2015**. Successful applicants will be notified by June 20, 2015.


